**APPLICATION:** 

Sponge application.

Shake the product well and use a damp sponge to apply VELATURA using big circular and crisscross movements. Take care not to press the sponge too hard on the surface to preventing dripping and running, and to cover the entire surface without leaving empty areas. During application, take care not to overlap application areas and if possible not to stop halfway through coating a wall, but at a joint or corner. Different application techniques and tools can be used to obtain finishes of varying uniformity, depending on taste and the setting in which they are applied.
